

Declaration on Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS) and Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 amending Annex II as regards the list of restricted substances

Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Union establishes regulations for restricting the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. It aims to prevent the risks posed to human health and the environment, also as regards the eco-friendly recycling and disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment.

Substances subject to restrictions under Article 4 (1) and maximum permitted concentrations in homogeneous materials in percent by weight:

- Lead (0.1%)
- Mercury (0.1%)
- Cadmium (0.01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1%)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1%)
- Di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%)

We require all our suppliers to verify compliance with the substance restrictions of the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU, by ensuring that products are provided with the corresponding CE mark in accordance with the requirements of the RoHS Directive as well as national implementation laws. For this purpose, we are in constant communication with our suppliers.

An internal team of experts evaluates all products for risk factors and supplied components are checked on a regular basis for compliance with substance restrictions and declaration obligations.

To the best of our knowledge and based on the information available to us, we declare that all items supplied by Baumer hhs comply with the above directive. Our products contain none of the restricted substances in excess of the maximum permissible concentrations specified in the directive, taking into account the exemptions under Annex III and IV of Directive 2011/65/EU.

We also inform you that we apply exemptions in accordance with Annex III for some products. Baumer hhs products are mainly subject to the exemptions established under RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, Annex III: 6a/b/c, 7a, 7b and 7c.I.
